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Summary of Dressage Rules and Judging Criteria

SUIT—Suitability to Be a Dressage Horse – judged on horse's potential for dressage work. To walk, trot and canter both directions. Open to any horse/rider combination.

JREQ—Dressage Equitation for Junior Riders – judged on correctness of rider's seat and correct use of the aids for dressage. Open to any junior rider (18 and under)

ADEQ- Dressage Equitation for Adults – judged on correctness of rider's seat and correct use of the aids for dressage. Open to any adult rider (19 and over)

WEQJ—Walk-Trot Dressage Basics for Juniors – judged both on rider's seat and aids, and correct basics of horse/pony. Riders will walk and trot only (no canter) Open to any junior rider showing Intro Level only.

WEQA—Walk-Trot Dressage Basics for Adults - judged both on rider's seat and aids, and correct basics of horse/pony. Riders will walk and trot only (no canter) Open to any adult rider showing Intro Level only.

Closing Date: 10 days before show
Absolutely no Refunds will be given after closing date.

- All horses are required to wear an assigned number while on the show grounds. Non-competing horses must fill out an entry form and receive a number to school.
- Management reserves the right to split or combine classes to balance entries.
- **Membership:** All competitors must be current members of TRSC at time of competition. Please see Secretary for membership details.
- **Improve Your Ride**—Can sign up at show after your ride, limited to 6 rides per show, first come, first serve. Standard class fees apply.
- **Arena:** One 20 x 60 meter arena with grass footing. Ample grass warm up areas.
- **Ride Times:** Times will be available at www.TRSC.us after 6:00 pm on Thursday before the show. Any questions can be directed to Stephany at 561-262-0807.
- **Attire:** Proper show attire is encouraged; however, riders may choose to wear a polo style shirt, tucked in, instead of the traditional shirt, stock tie and coat. Boots, breeches and hard hat are required (Derbys and Top Hats OK over 18).
- Haul Ins ONLY. Water available, as well as restrooms.
- **Awards:** Prize of choice for 1st place, ribbons to 6th place for all classes.
- ALL PETS MUST BE RESTRAINED AT ALL TIMES WHILE ON SHOW GROUNDS.
