## C RING Rules and Class Description



**December & April double point shows.  
You must show 4 of 6 shows to qualify for Year End Awards.**

Anyone who accepts compensation for riding, showing, training, giving instruction or lessons is considered a professional.

**All Hunter Under Saddle Classes (301, 308, 315, 318)**- To walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. To be judged on performance and way of going, with emphasis on manners and suitability to rider. Open and Low classes may be asked to Hand Gallop.

**All Equitation On The Flat (306, 313, 323)** - To walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance and control. May be asked to hand gallop

**Open Hunter Over Fences (302, 303)** - Open to all ages including **Professionals/Trainers**. To be shown over a course of not less than 8 fences at 2' 6" to 2' 9". To be judged on manners, suitability and way of going.

**Open Hunt Seat Equitation Over Fences (304, 305)** - Open to all ages including **Professionals/Trainers**. To be shown over a course of not less than 8 fences at 2' 6" to 2' 9". To be judged on hands, seat, guidance and control. USEF Tests 1-18

**TRSC Medal Class (307)** - Open to all ages including Professionals/Trainers. The Medal Class is an Equitation Test over fences for the intermediate to advanced competitor, following the USEF guidelines for Equitation and Medal classes. There may be a call back test for the top competitors, at the judge's discretion. USEF Tests 1-18

**Low Hunter Over Fences (309-310)** - Open to all ages including **Professionals/Trainers**. To be shown over a course of not less than 8 fences at 2' 3". To be judged on manners, suitability and way of going.

**Low Equitation Over Fences (311-312)** - Open to all ages. **No Professionals**. To be shown over a course of not less than 8 fences at 2' 3". To be judged on hands, seat, guidance and control.

**Low Mini Medal (314)** - Open to all ages. **No Professionals**. This is an Equitation class to be shown over a course of not less than 8 fences at 2'3". To be judged on hands, seat, guidance and control. There may be a call back test for the top competitors, at the judge's discretion. USEF Test 1-9

**Green Hunter Division (315, 316, 317)** - Open to all ages including **Professionals/Trainers**. For Horses who are in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Trotting not to be penalized. Same Rider/Horse combination may enter any 2 ft division. Judged on manners and way of going. To be shown over a course at 2'. No Combinations.

**Child/Adult Division: No Professionals** - This division is for the rider who is no longer eligible for the short/long stirrups or the novice division, but is not ready to jump higher than 2'.

**Child/Adult Hunter Over Fences (319-320)** Open to all ages. To be judged on manners, suitability and way of going.

**Child/Adult Equitation Over Fences (321-322)** Open to all ages. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance and control.

**Child/Adult Mini Medal (324)** - Open to all ages. This is an Equitation class to be shown over a course of not less than 8 fences at 2'. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance and control. There may be a call back test for the top competitors at the judge's discretion. USEF 1-9.
