**December & April double point shows.**

**You must show 4 of 6 regular season shows to qualify for Year End Awards.**

### **Halter Divisions- Must Show 3 of 7 classes for Daily High Point & Year End Award**

Pony Halter - 401,403,404,405,406,407, 412, and any (1) of the halter classes 409-411 according to age restrictions

Halter 17 & under - 401,403,404,405,406,409,412

Novice Halter - 401,403,404,405,406,410,412

Adult Halter - 401,403,404,405,406,411,412

### **Walk/Jog Divisions - Must show 3 of 5 classes for Daily High Point & Year End Award**

Walk/Jog 17 & under - 414,415,420,421, and any one (1) of the halter classes 401-412

Walk/Jog Novice - 416,417,420,421, and any one (1) of the halter classes 401-412

Walk/Jog Adult - 418,419,420,421, and any one (1) of the halter classes 401-412

Pre-Western - 422,423, and any one (1) of the halter classes 401-412

### **Western Pleasure Divisions - Must show in 3 of 4 classes for Daily High Point & Year End Award**

Western Pleasure 17 & under - 426,427,432, and any one (1) of the halter classes 401-412

Western Pleasure Novice - 428,429,432, and any one (1) of the halter classes 401-412

Western Pleasure Adult - 430,431,432, and any one (1) of the halter classes 401-412

### **Walk/Trot Divisions - Must show in 3 of 4 classes for Daily High Point & Year End Award**

Walk/Trot 17 & under - 436,437,442, and any one (1) of the halter classes 401-412

Walk/Trot Novice - 438,439,442, and any one (1) of the halter classes 401-412

Walk/Trot Adult - 440,441,442 and any one (1) of the halter classes 401-412

Pre-English - 443,444 and any one (1) of the halter classes 401-412

### **English Pleasure Divisions - Must show in 3 of 5 classes for Daily High Point & Year End Award**

English Pleasure 17 & under - 448,449,454,455, and any one (1) of the halter classes 401-412

English Pleasure Novice - 450,451,454,455, and any one (1) of the halter classes 401-412

English Pleasure Adult - 452,453,454,455, and any one (1) of the halter classes 401-412

### **Halter Classes**

To be shown in hand. To be judged on: way of going, soundness, confirmation, manners, and proper weight. Horses should be groomed to breed specifications. Will be asked to walk, jog/trot and line up. Handlers should be properly attired. Horses are to be shown in a lead shank of adequate length and strength.

### **Grooming**

To be shown in hand. To be judged on grooming details and condition. Horses should be of proper weight, properly cleaned and clipped. Will be asked to walk, jog/trot. While in line up horses should be mannerly and stand quietly for Judge's inspection.

### **Color**

Must be color breed (Paint, Pinto, Palomino, Appaloosa or Buckskin). To be shown in hand. To be judged on brilliance of color or contrast. Will be asked to walk and line up.

### **Novice**

These classes are for exhibitors who have not won five (5) blue ribbons. Ribbons won in this division during this show season do not affect your status for the year. Exhibitor may stay in this division for the whole year.

### **Showmanship at Halter**

To be judged on Handler's ability to exhibit the horse to the best advantage. Handlers will be required to demonstrate proper showmanship and safety. May be asked to answer questions asked by the judge. Enter class according to age restriction.

### **Model Hunter**

To be shown in hand in a bridle with the exhibitor in proper English Attire. To be judged on confirmation, soundness and way of going. Horses under 2 years of age may be shown in halter.

### **Lead Line**

Riders may not enter any other riding class on the day of the show in which they exhibit in lead line.

### **Walk/Trot/Jog Pleasure/Equitation/Horsemanship**

Open to riders with age restriction as specified in class list or by novice specifications. Riders to walk and trot/jog both ways of the ring.

### **Pre-Western Classes/Pre-English Classes**

This is for riders just learning to lope/canter. Rider can cross enter into Walk/Jog, Walk/Trot Classes, **but no other lope/canter classes.**

### **English/Western Pleasure**

To be judged on performance and ability to give a good pleasure ride with emphasis on manners.

### **Equitation/Horsemanship**

To be judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of Horse/Pony. Pattern may be asked for by the judge and/or may be asked to back.

### **Jr./Sr. Horse**

Horse's age is determined as of January 1st. Jr. Horse (5 yrs and younger) must show proof of age.

### **Trail First Year Horse/Beginner Rider**

This class is an introduction to a Trail class. The class is open to both green trail horse and the beginner trail rider who has never shown in the open trail class. This class is open to English and Western riders (walk/trot/jog) and will only have four (4) to six (6) simple obstacles. It will be judged on the performance of the horse over obstacles with emphasis on manners, response to the rider, and attitude. This class is a walk/jog/trot only.

### **Trail 17 & under**

This class is for riders 17 years and under. To be judged on rider's ability to negotiate a course of 4 to 6 simple obstacles. Riders will have two (2) tries at the obstacle before being asked to move on.

### **Trail Adult**

This class will be judged on the performance of the horse over obstacles with emphasis on manners, response to the rider, and attitude. Horse shall be penalized for any unnecessary delay while approaching the obstacles. Credit will be given to those horses negotiating the obstacles with style, providing that carefulness is not sacrificed. Credit will be giving to horses showing capability of picking their way through courses when obstacles warrant it, and willingly responding to rider's cues on more difficult obstacles.
