Rules:

Professionals are allowed in Open and Green classes.
Professionals are eligible for Green highpoint.

Riders may enter Open classes in lower height divisions for warm up or additional schooling but will not be eligible for highpoint in the lower height division.

Participants interested in highpoint will pay a highpoint fee (5\$) at time of entry. Highpoint will be closed out to new entries once that highpoint's division has started.

Highpoint will be awarded to the rider with the most cumulated points in that highpoint category. Highpoint participants will receive 1 point for each contestant the rider places above in a class, not all class entries need to be highpoint participants to gain points.

Maximum points for a 1st place is 7 points.

*In a class of 3 entries, 1st place will receive 3 points. 2nd place/2 points. 3rd place/1 point.

*In a class of 15 entries, 1st/7 points, 2nd/6 points, 3rd/ 5 points... etc.

Single riders in a class, who are participating in highpoint, will receive 1 point.

A rider can win highpoint by default if they are the only participant in that highpoint.

The same horse/rider combination must be maintained in all highpoint classes to be eligible for that highpoint.

Schooling- Schooling will be open as soon as the jump course has been set up following the completion of Pleasure ring. Riders may warm up on the rail while jumps are being set up with respect given to the safety of any persons on the ground. If safety is a concern, any TRSC worker or volunteer may request for the ring to be cleared.

All Hunter Under Saddle Classes - Open to all ages. To walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. To be judged on performance and way of going, with emphasis on manners and suitability to rider. In the 18" division, classes larger than 6 entries will be split for canter work.

All Hunter Over Fences Classes - Open to all ages. To be judged on manners, suitability, and way of going.

All Equitation on the Flat - Open to all ages. To walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Rider to be judged on hands, seat, guidance, and control. In the 18" division, classes larger than 6 entries will be split for canter work. Riders may be asked to sit trot, 2pt, and hand gallop.

All Equitation Over Fences Classes - Open to all ages. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance, and control.

Novice over Fences 18"- (107-108) These classes are intended for the Rider that is **STARTING** to canter over fences. Riders may trot the entire course or may trot into the first fence of the line and canter out of the line. Canter over the course will be penalized. To jump a simple course of 4 to 8 fences at 18".

Open Classes- Open classes are open to all ages including professionals. Riders from other height divisions may also enter open classes in lower height divisions for schooling or warm up but will not be eligible for the lower height divisions highpoint.

Green Classes- A horse who qualifies as Green will be in its first year of showing or has won 5 or fewer ribbons. Green classes are open to all ages and professionals.

Thoroughbred Classes- Open to all ages who will be competing on a Thoroughbred horse. Proof of breed via Coggins paper will need to be verified at the office upon entry.

Jumpers-

Table II, Sec. 1—The first round is decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. Horses with clear rounds or equal faults are classified according to their time taken to complete the course.

Table II, Sec. 2 (b)—The first round and first jump-off, if any, are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. Each exhibitor has the option of taking part in the jump-off at the completion of their round. If there are no clear rounds and a tie exists for first place, the results will be determined by the scores and time from that round.
