Schooling-Jumps will be set up Saturday afternoon after the completion of Pleasure series and the arena will be open for schooling. Schooling will be limited Sunday morning and throughout the day and it is recommended to utilize the flat and warm up classes offered.

Limited Canter Division-The limited canter division is for riders just learning to canter. The canter portion of each class will be done individually. Participants will walk and trot both directions. Riders may be asked to two point, perform sitting trot, and back up.

Beginner division – The beginner division is for riders who are learning to trot a simple course. Riders will trot the entire course. Excessive cantering will be penalized. Only 3 horses at a time will canter in the flat portion.

Novice Division – (Previously Pre-Short/Long Division) The novice division is for riders who are learning to canter a simple course. Trotting will not be penalized. Riders may trot the entire course or trot in/canter out. A consistent pace will score higher than an inconsistent one.

18"-2'6" Divisions

Novice classes- These classes are intended for riders who are in their first year of showing in the specified height division. Novice riders may also show in any other classes within their height division. At 18" the Novice rider may still trot in and canter out, but will be expected to canter the full course in non-novice 18" classes.

18" Division: Trot in and canter out is acceptable in Novice classes only at 18". Novice riders are expected to canter the full course in non-Novice classes. Simple lead changes are also acceptable.

2' Division: The rider is expected to canter the full course, excessive trotting will be penalized. Simple lead changes are accepted.

2'3" Division and higher: Oxers will be added in the 2'3" division and higher. Riders will be expected to canter the full course (unless otherwise noted in the pattern) and perform flying lead changes.

Warm up classes- Warm up classes are open to all riders in all height divisions and may be utilized for extra schooling. Professionals and green horses may show in warm up classes.

Equitation- Equitation classes are judged on the riders posture and use of their aids while on the flat or navigating a course of fences. An equitation course will consist of challenging maneuvers such as roll back turns, bending lines, trot fences, etc. These maneuvers are to test the riders skills and partnership with their horse.

TRSC Medal- An equitation over fences class that may be more challenging than a regular equitation course.

Hunter- Hunter classes are judged on the manners and movement of the horse. Obedience and relaxation along with a forward pace are sought after in a hunter horse. Over fences, a hunter remains relaxed and forward, maintaining a consistent pace.

Handy Hunter- The handy hunter class is a hunter over fences class that challenges the horse and rider to a course of jumps that resemble what can be encountered in the hunt field. Tight turns and changes of pace can be asked. The horse will be judged on manners and obedience along with the teams consistency and overall appearance.

Open Classes: Open classes are open to any riders within the specified height division. Professionals and green horses may enter open classes. Professionals will not be considered in Daily Grand and Reserve or year end awards.

Daily Grand and Reserve will be awarded to riders participating in 3 division classes with a minimum of 3 riders in each class. 18"-2'6" must show in at least 1 flat class to qualify for Grand/Reserve. Professionals will not be considered in daily grand and reserve or end of the year awards.
